#### GENERAL INFORMATION

Do not apply this product through any type of irrigation system.

- *Chateau* WDG provides residual control of susceptible weeds in onion (dry bulb).

#### GENERAL RESTRICTIONS AND LIMITATIONS

- Do not apply to frozen or snow covered soil.
- Mechanical incorporation into the soil will reduce residual weed control.
- **Spray equipment used to apply *Chateau* WDG should not be used to apply other materials to any crop foliage, unless the proper clean out procedure is followed. See "SPRAYER CLEANUP" on the container label for more information.**

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE IN ONION (DRY BULB)

#### GENERAL RESTRICTIONS AND LIMITATIONS

- Do not apply more than 2 oz of *Chateau* WDG per acre during a single application.
- Do not apply more than 3 oz of *Chateau* WDG per acre during a single growing season.
- Do not make sequential application within 14 days of the first application, unless otherwise directed by supplemental labeling issued by Valent U.S.A. Corporation.
- Do not apply more than 1 oz of *Chateau* WDG per season on soils that contain greater than 90% sand plus gravel.
- Application with an adjuvant, or as part of a tank mix, may result in unacceptable crop injury.
- Do not apply within 45 days of harvest.

#### TIMING TO ONIONS (dry bulb)

*Chateau* WDG may be applied to transplanted onions (dry bulb) between the 2-leaf and 6-leaf stage and on direct seed onions (dry bulb) between the 3-leaf and 6-leaf stage.

#### TIMING TO WEEDS

##### Preemergence – Emerged Onions (dry bulb), Preemergence To Weeds

Apply *Chateau* WDG to weed-free onions (dry bulb) for preemergence control of the weeds listed in Table 1, Broadleaf Weeds Controlled by Residual Activity of *Chateau* WDG, Section A.

Read tank mix product label for rates and weeds controlled. Always read and follow label directions for all tank mix products before using. The most restrictive labeling of any tank mix product must be followed. *Chateau* WDG, when applied according to label use directions, will control the weeds listed in Table 1, Broadleaf Weeds Controlled by Residual Activity of *Chateau* WDG, Section A. This label makes no claims concerning control of other weed species.
