DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use these products in a manner inconsistent with their labeling.

Do not apply these products through any type of irrigation system.

GENERAL INFORMATION

COMMAND7 4 EC may be utilized as a preemergent soil applied (see geographic restrictions) or soil incorporated treatment for control of annual grass and broadleaf weeds in soybeans. Following an application of COMMAND, a postemergence application with COBRA7 may be applied for control of additional broadleaf weed species at lower rates than possible following other preemergent herbicides.

A temporary crop response should be expected following a postemergence application of COBRA. Soybeans quickly outgrow all initial herbicide effects, and all new growth following initial crop response will be normal. The lower rates of COBRA will reduce the level of crop response seen.

IMPORTANT

This supplemental labeling contains directions for use which do not appear on the package labels of COBRA or COMMAND. Follow instructions carefully. Read and carefully observe all the precautionary statements, instructions, rotational restrictions, and all other information appearing on each product's package label. This label must be in the possession of the user at the time of application.

COMMAND GEOGRAPHIC RESTRICTIONS:

COMMAND 47 EC must be soil incorporated in Iowa unless an approved 24 (c) is on file for counties within the state.

COMMAND APPLICATION PRECAUTIONS FOR PREEMERGENCE USE

Except as restricted above, COMMAND may be used as a preemergence soil applied treatment without incorporation, however, additional precautions, beyond those required for a soil incorporated treatment, must be taken as follows:

Do not apply COMMAND 4 EC within 1,500 feet of the following areas: Towns and Subdivisions, Commercial Fruit or Vegetable* Production, and Commercial Greenhouses or Nurseries. Prior to application, adjacent properties must be checked, and spraying within 1,500 feet of desirable plants avoided except sweet corn.

COBRA APPLICATION PRECAUTIONS

Do not apply COBRA when the soybeans or weeds are under stress. Use of an EPA approved spray adjuvant is required. In dry weather conditions, crop oil concentrate adjuvant is required. Properly timed treatments with COBRA will provide consistent performance on labeled weeds with minimal crop response. Refer to the COBRA package label for specific recommendations and requirements.

COBRA applied as a postemergence application (**not a tank mix**) following a 1.5 pt. per acre treatment of COMMAND will control the additional broadleaf weeds at a reduced rate.

** Higher rates (a minimum of 2 pts. of COMMAND per acre) are recommended for fields that have previously been in conservation programs, or where heavy weed pressure is anticipated. Select lower to higher rates based on lighter to heavier soils.

NOTE: When using COMMAND as a surface treatment more than 30 days prior to planting, the highest label rate (2 pts.) should be used. COBRA should be applied to small, actively growing weeds (normally 14 to 21 days after planting). The 12.5 oz/A rate of COBRA is required if applied to weeds at sizes not specified on this label. A timely cultivation approximately one week to ten days after the application of COBRA will assist in weed control.

ROTATIONAL GUIDELINES

Rotate to crops as listed below (following 1.5 pt. per acre rate of COMMAND), otherwise crop injury may occur. Refer to COMMAND label for Rotational Guidelines at higher rates.

Cover crops, however, may be planted anytime, but stand reductions may occur in some areas. Do not graze or harvest for food or feed cover crops planted less than 9 months after COMMAND 4 EC treatment.

Do not allow livestock to graze on treated soybean vines or feed treated vines or vine trash to livestock.
