USE *BELAY* INSECTICIDE FOR EXOTIC WHITE GRUB AND WIREWORM CONTROL IN SWEET POTATOES

Crop	Product	Pest	Product Rate	Special Instructions
Sweet Potatoes	<i>Belay</i> Insecticide	Exotic White Grub Wireworm *	12 fl oz/A (0.2 lb ai/A)	Apply preplant incorporated prior to transplanting the sweet potato slips.

**Belay* Insecticide provides wireworm suppression.

Use Restrictions for *Belay* Insecticide when applied preplant incorporated on sweet potatoes:

1. Always read and follow all label directions, restrictions and precautions when using any pesticide alone or in tank mix combinations. The most restrictive labeling applies when using a tank mix.
2. Do not make foliar applications of neonicotinoid insecticides (Group 4A) after soil applications of *Belay* Insecticide.
Refer to *Belay* Insecticide label for additional insects controlled.
3. Do not apply more than a total of 12 fl oz of *Belay* Insecticide (0.2 lb ai) per acre per season.

This 2(ee) bulletin contains directions for use, which do not appear on the package label of *Belay* Insecticide. Follow instructions carefully.

Follow all applicable directions, restrictions and precautions on the EPA-registered label.

It is a violation of Federal law to use these products in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
