#### RECOMMENDED TURFGRASS SPECIES:

Bentgrass, Kentucky Bluegrass, Annual Bluegrass and Perennial Ryegrass

#### APPLICATION DIRECTIONS:

Apply Tourney<sup>®</sup> Fungicide using standard, low pressure spray equipment designed to deliver coarse to medium size spray droplets. Apply in a sufficient volume of water to provide thorough spray coverage and a uniform spray pattern. Spray boom height should be no higher than 20 inches.

#### RESTRICTIONS AND LIMITATIONS

1. Do not apply more than 4 lb (2 lb ai) of product per acre per year.
2. Do not apply through any type of irrigation system.
3. Do not apply by air.
4. Do not graze animals on treated areas of one year after application.
5. Do not feed plants from treated areas to livestock or poultry.

Follow all applicable directions, restrictions and precautions on the EPA-registered labels.
