


|Tree Nuts|

How To Use

Rate 10-2/3 – 21-1/3 oz/A

Timing Apply when first pest activity is noticed and repeat as needed. Wait at

least 10 days between applications.

Method Ground application with airblast equipment as a full cover spray

Spray volume 50 – 400 gal/A

PHI: 1 day in tropical / sub-tropical fruits; 3 days in pome fruit, stone fruit

PHI / REI and tree nuts

REI 24 hours



Other Important Information

- For resistance management, rotate types of chemistry; use non-pyrethroid products in rotation with *Danitol*. Try to avoid applying more than two *Danitol* applications per season.
- Apply up to 42-2/3 fl oz of Danitol 2.4 EC Spray per acre per season
